Fortescue Anderson Point Sealed Feeder Upgrade

Client: Fortescue

Period: August 2025

DC Capabilities: E&I Installation

Synopsis: Dynamical Construction was engaged to deliver the full electrical works package as part of a major apron feeder replacement project. This scope involved the safe and efficient removal of an existing feeder and the installation of a new unit, including the complete upgrade and replacement of the associated hydraulic power unit (HPU).

Our team managed the electrical disconnection of all feeder and HPU electrical systems. This was followed by the installation of new electrical infrastructure to suit the upgraded mechanical configuration, including power and control wiring, and all termination works. We provided testing, inspection, and commissioning support to ensure a safe and seamless transition into operation.

All works were executed within a brownfield environment and aligned with a tightly controlled shutdown schedule, requiring close coordination across multiple trades and client stakeholders.



Hancock Iron Ore Mine & Port Slew Bearing Changeouts

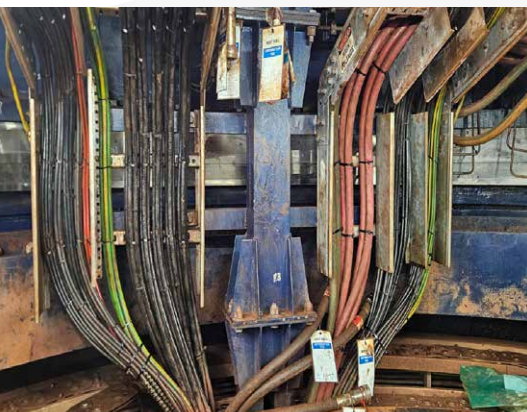

Synopsis: Dynamical Construction was engaged to deliver the complete electrical scope required to support the mechanical replacement of two critical slew bearings at Hancock Iron Ore, Mine and Port. We oversaw the disconnection, removal, and tagging of existing electrical infrastructure in strict compliance with site protocols and sequencing.

Following replacement, our team re-installed all electrical cabling, completed all necessary terminations. We performed the full inspection and testing of all electrical work to ensure compliance with OEM specifications and client standards.

To support a smooth restart, we remained on-site through commissioning, assisting with energisation and functional testing alongside the mechanical and controls teams. The electrical scope was delivered safely and on time.





Fortescue Anderson Point Festoon Replacements

Clients: Metso / Fortescue

Period: November 2023 & October 2024

DC Capabilities: E&I Management Services, E&I Installation

Synopsis: Dynamical Construction were engaged by the OEM Metso on behalf of Fortescue to perform the construction management and trades execution works for two festoon replacements on the Car Positioners/Train Unloaders at Anderson Point.

Dynamical Construction self-performed all electrical works on the projects and engaged and managed supporting services such as mechanical trades, cranes/riggers, surveyors, NDT, and lubrication/piping specialists to facilitate the successful execution.

The projects involved the removal of the existing and installation of new car positioner/train unloader festoons, runway beams and toe arms. The new festoon cabling was installed in existing cable ladder to both the land side and onboard enclosures and equipment. All cabling was terminated and tested prior to supporting the re-commissioning of the machine which was handed back on schedule. Both projects listed over 4000 man-hours each and were each expended over 13 days with no reportable safety incidents.

Fortescue Anderson Point VVVF Upgrades

Clients: Metso / Fortescue

Period: August 2024 & November 2025

Synopsis: Dynamical Construction was commissioned to construction manage and perform trade execution tasks associated with the TUL2 & TUL3 VVVF Upgrades. The company conducted all electrical aspects of this project while effectively coordinating and managing ancillary services including mechanical trades and crane operations.

Our team successfully managed the entire project installation scope, which included the safe removal of the old drives, installation of the new VVVF units, and thorough testing and commissioning to ensure optimal performance. This projects were executed within the scheduled timeframes, with a strong emphasis on safety and minimal disruption to ongoing operations.

The upgrades have resulted in significant improvements in the speed and control of operations, contributing to reduced energy consumption and extended equipment lifespan, aligning with Fortescue's commitment to operational excellence and sustainability

These projects were marked by a significant commitment of over 4400 man-hours across two shutdowns each with a span of 13 days, and it is noteworthy that this extensive work was accomplished without any reportable safety incidents.



Fortescue Anderson Point MCC Upgrade

Client: Fortescue

DC Capabilities: E&I Installation

Synopsis: Dynamical Construction were engaged by Fortescue to perform the trades execution works relating to a MCC Upgrade on TUL1 Train Unloader at Anderson Point. The company conducted all electrical aspects of this project excluding the commissioning which was tackled by the client.

The projects main objective was to install a new MCC for the TUL1 basement. While the project didn't call for design, we excelled in the execution. We prioritized quality craftsmanship and efficiency.



Rio Tinto Paraburdoo Bucketwheel Changeout

Head Client: Rio Tinto

Period: December 2023

DC Capabilities: E&I Installation

Synopsis: Dynamical Construction was contracted to execute the electrical work required for the bucketwheel changeout on Bridge Reclaimer 1 at Paraburdoo. This project entailed the disconnection of all electrical equipment situated on the crab structure, followed by the retraction of cables above the mechanical disconnection point, a crucial step in facilitating the bucketwheel changeout. Subsequent to this phase, the personnel from Dynamical Construction returned to the project site to reinstate the previously removed cabling and equipment.

In the final stages of the project, all cabling underwent thorough termination and testing processes before the re-commissioning of the affected systems. In addition to these tasks, Dynamical Construction provided comprehensive in-house support for control systems throughout the duration of the project.





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
